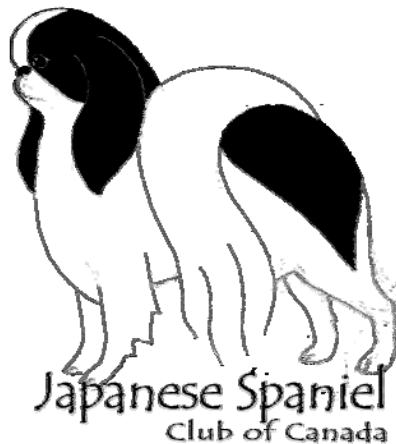

Championship Points and Cancellations Section 15)

- 1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.
- 1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Awarded	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

- 1.3 If a Dog awarded Winners was also awarded Best of Breed then at the show all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included the total.
- 1.4 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total.
- 1.5 If a Dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.
- 1.6 If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.
- 1.7 The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.
Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Male shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials Bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.
- 1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that the dog was defeated at the Group level.
- 1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show.
- 1.10 A breed or class shall not be allowed more than 2 sets of championship points per sex on any day in the same venue.
- 1.11 A dog awarded Winners which also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.
- 1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:
 - (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 judges; and,
 - (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number.
 - (c) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

EARLY DAYS

from Joan Brazier

Back in the year 2000, a few of us who were showing and breeding Japanese Spaniels decided that the breed deserved a club. Bev Rogers and I were soon joined by Lotty Potts, Carol Truman, Carole Holtom, Susan Norris-Jones and others.

Bravely we decided we wanted a National Club. We soon acquired members from across the country: the Jensens from New Brunswick; Joan Bagnell from Nova Scotia; Sherrill Morrison, Carol Howarth, Rose Smith from Ontario; Don Brown, Kim McKay, Murray Berg, Gail Forsythe from Alberta; and Jean Whitford, a long time breeder from Quebec. Jean became our first President.

We were soon faced with the daunting task of producing a Constitution. After much hard work and some frustration, we finally achieved an acceptable version and the Japanese Spaniel Club of Canada received C.K.C. Recognition in December 2003. The club now has 30 members and is about to hold its third Specialty.

We will always be grateful to the founding members whose dedication and hard work helped us reach where we are today.

Japanese Spaniel Breed Standard

General Appearance

That of a lively, high-bred little dog with smart, dainty appearance, compact carriage and profuse coat.

Size

In size they vary considerably, but the smaller they are the better, provided type and quality are not sacrificed. When divided by weight, classes should be under and over 7 lb.(3 kg).

Coat and Colour

Coat profuse, long, straight, rather silky. It should be absolutely free from wave or curl, and not lie too flat, but have a tendency to stand out, especially at the neck, so as to give a thick mane or ruff, which with profuse feathering on thighs and tail gives a very showy appearance. The dogs should be either black and white or red and white, i.e., particoloured. The term red includes all shades of sable, brindle, lemon and orange, but the brighter and clearer the red the better. The white should be clear white, and the colour, whether black or red, should be evenly distributed patches over the body, cheek, and ears.

Head

Should be large for the size of the dog, with broad skull, rounded in front. Nose very short in the muzzle part. The end or nose proper should be wide, with open nostrils, and must be the colour of the dog's markings, i.e., black in black-marked dogs, and red or deep flesh colour in red or lemon-marked dogs. It shall be a disqualification for a black and white Japanese Spaniel to have a nose any other colour than black. Eyes large, dark, lustrous, rather prominent and set wide apart. Ears small and V-shaped, nicely feathered, set wide apart and high on the head and carried slightly forward.

Neck

Should be short and moderately thick.

Breed standard, continued

Forequarters

The bones of the legs should be small, giving them a slender appearance, and they should be well feathered.

Body

Should be squarely and compactly built, wide in chest, cobby in shape. The length of the dog's body should be about its height.

Hindquarters

Feet small and shaped somewhat long; the dog stands up on its toes somewhat. If feathered, the tufts should never increase in width of the foot, but only its length a trifle.

Tail

Must be well twisted to either right or left from root and carried up overback and flow on opposite side; it should be profusely covered with long hair (ring tails not desirable).

Gait

These dogs should be essentially stylish in movement, lifting the feet high when in action, carrying the tail (which is heavily feathered, proudly curved or plumed) over the back.

Disqualifications

In black and whites, a nose any other colour than black.
